The Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) is a Mediterranean country located in the northern part of Cyprus, in the Eastern Mediterranean. As of 2011, its population was 294,906. The country is home to five major cities, each with its own unique charm and historical significance: Lefkoşa (the capital), Famagusta, Kyrenia, Güzelyurt, and Lefke. Highlights of the island include the Selimiye Mosque (formerly St. Sophia Cathedral), the Bellapais Monastery, and the breathtaking Karpaz Peninsula.

To help all our students explore the island's beauty, our university will be organizing city tours throughout the academic year. Dates and times of the tours will be announced on the university's official website, as well as its Facebook and Instagram pages.

CURRENCY AND CREDIT CARD USAGE

The currency used in North Cyprus is the Turkish Lira. As the average exchange rate can fluctuate throughout the day, it is best to check the daily rate at a bank or bureau de change before changing your money. Most of the shops also accept Euros, Pounds and US Dollars. All internationally recognized credit and debit cards are valid in hotels, restaurants and shops.

BANKS

Northern Cyprus offers a good service in this sense with an average of 10 banks in each major city. For many banks, opening and closing hours differ in summer and winter shifts.

Application for Student Permit

Upon completion of the registration process, all new and current students are required to apply for a Student Permit through the official government portal. Immigration procedures are carried out by the Student Affairs Department. Travel Advisory

Students are strongly advised not to travel until the student permit process is fully completed (100%). Traveling before final approval may lead to complications with your residency permit.

Postgraduate Student Permit Requirement

Postgraduate students (Masters and PhD) must hold a valid student permit throughout the thesis process, article pending periods, and graduation processes.

University of Kyrenia Dormitories

Students of the University of Kyrenia have access to university dormitories located in Karakum, Kyrenia, as well as the dormitory facilities of Near East University (NEU), including Park Palace Residence Dormitories, Apart Dormitories, and Park Palace Residence 74 Phoenix Dormitories.

Dormitory rooms can be rented on a semester or full academic year basis. Applications for dormitory registration can be submitted either on campus or through our representative offices abroad.

Park Palace Residence Dormitories

Conveniently located within walking distance of the university campus in Karakum, Kyrenia, our dormitories offer students a variety of accommodation options to suit their needs. In addition to shared rooms for 1, 2, 3, or 4 students, we also offer 1+1 and 2+1 studio apartments for those seeking more privacy and comfort.

Our university library houses over I million printed resources in various languages and provides access to more than 700 million online resources. It also features special collections such as the Rare Works Collection, the UK National Archive, and the Cyprus Documents Special Collection.

The University of Kyrenia Grand Library includes:

English Proficiency and Placement Examination


